The Prophet (سلمو عليه الله صلى) once climbed the mountain of U<u>h</u>ud with Abu Bakr, 'Umar and 'Uthman. The mountain shook with them. The Prophet (سلمو عليه الله صلى) said (to the mountain), "Be firm, O U<u>h</u>ud! For on you there are no more [Bukhari 3675] than a Prophet, a Siddeeq and two martyrs."

The Constantly Truthful

'Aaisha (و عنه الله صلى سلم) said, "(The night) after the Prophet (معنه الله صلى الله وعنه الله صلى الله ) went on his night journey to Al-Masjid Al-Aqsa, the people began to talk about it. Some people apostatized (on that day), having previously believed in the Prophet (و عليه الله صلى سلم) and having had faith in him. A number of men went to Abu Bakr and said, 'Will you not go to your companion? He claims that he went on a night-journey last night to Jerusalem!' He responded, 'And did he indeed say that?' They said, 'Yes'. He said, 'If he said that, then he spoke the truth.' They said, 'And do you truly believe him when he says that he traveled to Jerusalem last night and returned just before the beginning of this morning?' He said, 'Yes, I do indeed believe him about matters that are even more amazing that that: I believe him about news that comes to him from the heavens in the early morning or in the afternoon.' And it is because of this incident that he was named Abu Bakr As-Siddeeq."

- His calves were skinny, but his legs were lean and muscular












The Wives of Abu Bakr As-Siddeeq




