Breakers of Wudū'

- 1. Anything which exits from the front and back passage of the private parts.
- 2. Losing consciousness such as falling asleep, except for sleeping when firmly seated on the ground.
- 3. The flow of blood or pus from the body.
- 4. Blood in the mouth that dominates or is equal to the saliva (indicated by color).
- 5. Vomiting a mouthful (when one is unable to close one's mouth except through difficulty).
- 6. For an adult to laugh loudly during Salah.

Fard (Obligatory) Acts in Wudū'

- 1. Washing the face.
- 2. Washing both hands and arms including the elbows.
- 3. Wiping at least ¼ of the head.
- 4. Washing the feet including the ankles.

Makrūh (Disliked) Actions in Wuḍū'

- 1. to waste water
- 2. to be miserly in using water
- 3. to splash water onto the face
- 4. to speak without a need
- 5. to seek assistance from another, without an excuse
- 6. To wipe the head 3 times with new water
